

Dear Friends,

The Gospel this weekend retells the story of the sinful woman who anointed the feet of Jesus and bathed His feet with her tears of repentance. The ever self-righteous Pharisee said to himself: "If this man were a prophet, he would know who and what sort of woman this is who is touching him, that she is a sinner." Of course Jesus is much more than simply a prophet, and yes, He knew exactly "what sort of woman" was touching Him. That is the point. Jesus knows us completely. Why did He take on our human nature and experience every human limit and suffering if not because He knew us completely. He freely chose to die and rose again because He knew exactly what sort of men and women we are. He loves us – not some idealized version of who we might be if only we could be better – but who we are as we are. It is our true self that He embraces.

Setting aside the knowledge Jesus has concerning this woman, I find that it is the knowledge of the woman concerning herself and who Jesus is that is most amazing. She is able to recognize the truth of her life as unpleasant as it is. She is honest. She feels shame, embarrassment, and fear no doubt, but she also expresses repentance which by its nature is hopeful. She is faith filled. She comes to Jesus to share the pain of her sin and is forgiven. Her courage leads to liberation. We are all invited to overcome the fear of self-discovery – the fear of exposing things about ourselves, even to ourselves or to a priest within the secrecy of the confessional, that we firmly believe render us unlovable. May we, like she, grow in trust and the freedom that come from Him.

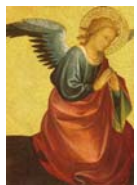
