12:00 - 3:00 pm, "TRE ORE," THE SEVEN LAST WORDS

The seven last words of Jesus as He is crucified on the cross are presented every 25 minutes, each with a congregational hymn and choral selections. The Good Friday collection assists the maintenance of the Shrines in the Holy Land.

3:00 PM, THE STATIONS of the CROSS

7:30 PM, THE VENERATION of the HOLY CROSS

At the Good Friday Liturgy we read the narrative of His Passion, pray for the Universal Church, venerate his Cross and receive Holy Communion.

10:00 pm, Night Prayer (Compline)
